A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE ARTS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 103-8.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended to read as follows:
- 3 "§103-8.5 Works of art special fund. (a) There is
- 4 created a works of art special fund, into which shall be
- 5 transferred one per cent of all state fund appropriations for
- 6 capital improvements designated for the construction cost
- 7 element; provided that this transfer shall apply only to capital
- 8 improvement appropriations that are designated for the
- 9 construction or renovation of state buildings. The one per cent
- 10 transfer requirement shall not apply to appropriations from the
- 11 passenger facility charge special fund established by section
- 12 261-5.5 and the rental motor vehicle customer facility charge
- 13 special fund established under section 261-5.6.
- 14 (b) The works of art special fund shall be used solely for
- 15 the following purposes:
- 16 (1) Costs related to the acquisition of works of art,
- including any consultant or staff services required to

- 15 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 3000.
