## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EDUCATION.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that out of the two
- 2 hundred fifty-eight public elementary, middle, and high schools
- 3 throughout the State, only seventy-five have a full-time or
- 4 part-time librarian position filled to support student learning
- 5 in 2025.
- 6 The purpose of this Act is to:
- 7 (1) Establish a two-year pilot program for two certified
- 8 librarians to provide rotating support services to
- 9 schools in one school complex on Oahu and one school
- 10 complex on a neighbor island; and
- 11 (2) Appropriate funds for the positions.
- 12 SECTION 2. (a) There is established within the department
- 13 of education a two-year pilot program for two certified
- 14 librarians to provide rotating support services to one school
- 15 complex on Oahu and one school complex on a neighbor island.
- 16 The department of education shall determine which school
- 17 complexes shall be part of the pilot program.

- 1 (b) The department of education shall submit a report to
- 2 the legislature no later than twenty days prior to the convening
- 3 of the regular sessions of 2026 and 2027. Each report shall
- 4 include findings and recommendations, including any proposed
- 5 legislation, about the pilot project established pursuant to
- 6 subsection (a). The report submitted prior to the convening of
- 7 the regular session of 2027 shall make a recommendation as to
- 8 whether the pilot project should be extended.
- 9 (c) The pilot program shall cease to exist on June 30,
- **10** 2027.
- 11 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general
- 12 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$132,308 or so much
- 13 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2025-2026 and the
- 14 same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year
- 15 2026-2027 for the establishment of two twelve-month state
- 16 office-level teacher positions under the department of education
- 17 for the pilot program established pursuant to section 2 of this
- 18 Act; provided that the funds appropriated shall be allocated as
- 19 follows:
