## HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

ENCOURAGING THE KAWAIHUELANI CENTER FOR HAWAIIAN LANGUAGE OF THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII AT MANOA TO FURTHER PROVIDE LEARNING RESOURCES AND OPPORTUNITIES THAT PROMOTE HAWAIIAN LANGUAGE AND CULTURE.

1 WHEREAS, Article XV, section 4 of the State Constitution recognizes both Hawaiian and English as the official languages 2 3 of Hawaii; and 4 5 WHEREAS, the Department of Education supports Hawaiian 6 language fluency through Kula Kaiapuni Hawaiian language 7 immersion schools across the State; and 8 9 WHEREAS, Kamehameha III established the first public 10 education system in the Kingdom of Hawaii in 1840, making Olelo Hawaii the first and only language of instruction at the time; 11 12 and 13 14 WHEREAS, the Republic of Hawaii passed section 30 of Act 57 in 1896, which made English the medium and basis of instruction 15 for all public and private schools, effectively removing Olelo 16 17 Hawaii from the classroom and the school system; and 18 19 WHEREAS, children who spoke Olelo Hawaii in school were 20 verbally and physically reprimanded and made to feel ashamed of their native tongue; and 21 22 WHEREAS, a group of Hawaiian language educators established 23 the Punana Leo Preschool in 1984 to provide an immersive 24 experience for preschool-aged children and their families to 25 26 learn Olelo Hawaii and adopt it as their primary means of communication; and 27 28

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WHEREAS, section 30 of Act 57 was repealed in 1986, 1 allowing for the establishment of the first Kula Kaiapuni in 2 1987; and 3 4 5 WHEREAS, although the growing participation in Kaiapuni 6 education has been unmatched, Kula Kaiapuni face struggles, such 7 as teacher shortages, insufficient facilities, and limited 8 support for curriculum development; and 9 10 WHEREAS, Kaiapuni students and their families encounter limited access to activities, materials, and learning 11 opportunities that they can do together to promote use of Olelo 12 13 Hawaii in the home; and 14 15 WHEREAS, the Kawaihuelani Center for Hawaiian Language of 16 the University of Hawaii at Manoa strives to revitalize Hawaiian language and culture through quality Hawaiian education by 17 18 creating and providing faculty, materials, curricula, and resources that promote the use of Hawaiian; and 19 20 21 WHEREAS, the Kawaihuelani Center for Hawaiian Language of 22 the University of Hawaii at Manoa created and implemented the I 23 Hoa na Moolelo Project in 2021 to publish a quarterly children's 24 magazine written in the Hawaiian language, for the enjoyment of Kaiapuni and charter school students in grades 2-6 on Oahu; and 25 26 27 WHEREAS, the Legislature recognizes the value and 28 importance of the practice and preservation of the Hawaiian 29 language and culture; now, therefore, 30 31 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the 32 Thirty-third Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session 33 of 2025, the Senate concurring, that the Kawaihuelani Center for 34 Hawaiian Language of the University of Hawaii at Manoa, through 35 its I Hoa na Moolelo Project, is encouraged to provide Kaiapuni 36 students and families with Hawaiian language and literacy 37 resources and to create opportunities for Olelo Hawaii to flourish in homes and communities; and 38 39
