
HOUSE RESOLUTION

URGING THE CITY AND COUNTY OF HONOLULU TO WORK WITH STAKEHOLDERS
TO CONSTRUCT A SIDEWALK FOR PEDESTRIAN SAFETY WHILE
TRAVELING BETWEEN IROQUOIS POINT AND EWA BEACH.

1 WHEREAS, the safety of pedestrians traveling from Iroquois
2 Point to Ewa Beach is of paramount importance; and
3

4 WHEREAS, the Hawaii Department of Transportation has
5 recognized the importance of available sidewalks by identifying
6 pedestrians and bicyclists as the most vulnerable roadway users;
7 and

9 WHEREAS, the lack of adequate lighting, presence of dense
10 bushes, and absence of sidewalks pose a significant risk of
11 accidents and jeopardize the safety of individuals in transit
12 between Iroquois Point and Ewa Beach; and

14 WHEREAS, it is imperative to address this safety concern
15 promptly to prevent potential accidents and protect lives; and

17 WHEREAS, the region between Iroquois Point and Ewa Beach
18 interests many stakeholders including private property owners,
19 the United States Navy, the City and County of Honolulu, and the
20 Ewa Beach Country Club; now, therefore,

22 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the
23 Thirty-third Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session
24 of 2025, that the City and County of Honolulu is urged to work
25 with stakeholders to construct a sidewalk for pedestrian safety
26 while traveling between Iroquois Point and Ewa Beach; and

28 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this
29 Resolution be transmitted to the Commander of Joint Base Pearl
30 Harbor-Hickam, Mayor of the City and County of Honolulu,
