A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CLIMATE CHANGE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the office of planning and sustainable development, rather than the department 2 3 of land and natural resources, is best equipped to effectively administer the Hawaii climate change mitigation and adaptation 4
- commission. The office of planning and sustainable development 5
- is responsible for supporting the principles of the State 6
- 7 Planning Act, including state priorities for climate change
- adaptation, and leads the State's coordination of sea level rise 8
- 9 adaptation activities.
- 10 The legislature further finds that the office of planning
- and sustainable development is charged with coordinating 11
- 12 activities across levels of government and ensuring cooperation
- to reach the State's goals. The legislature recognizes that 13
- comprehensive, coordinated action is necessary to combat the 14
- impacts of climate change. 15
- Accordingly, to promote public safety, efficiency, and 16
- effectiveness, the purpose of this Act is to transfer the Hawaii 17

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department of land and natural resources to the office of planning and sustainable development for administrative 3 4 purposes. SECTION 2. Section 225P-3, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 5 6 amended as follows: 7 1. By amending subsection (a) to read: "(a) There is established the Hawaii climate change 8 9 mitigation and adaptation commission that shall be placed within 10 the [department of land and natural resources] office of 11 planning and sustainable development for administrative purposes 12 only." 13 2. By amending subsection (c) to read: "(c) The commission shall include the following members: 14 15 The chairs of the standing committees of the (1)

17	(10)	The director of health or the director's designee;
18	(11)	The adjutant general or the adjutant general's
19		designee;
20	(12)	The chairperson of the board of education or the
21		chairperson's designee;

1	(13) The directors of each of the county planning		
2	departments, or the directors' designees; and		
3	(14) [The manager of the coastal zone management program.]		
4	A representative of the university of Hawaii."		
5	SECTION 3. All rights, powers, functions, and duties of		
6	the department of land and natural resources relating to the		
7	administration of the Hawaii climate change mitigation and		
8	adaptation commission are transferred to the office of planning		
9	and sustainable development.		
10	All officers and employees whose functions are transferred		
11	by this Act shall be transferred with their functions and shall		
12	continue to perform their regular duties upon their transfer,		
13	subject to the state personnel laws and this Act.		
14	No officer or employee of the State having tenure shall		
15	suffer any loss of salary, seniority, prior service credit,		
16	vacation, sick leave, or other employee benefit or privilege as		
17	a consequence of this Act, and such officer or employee may be		
18	transferred or appointed to a civil service position without the		
19	necessity of examination; provided that the officer or employee		
20	possesses the minimum qualifications for the position to which		
21	transferred or appointed; and provided that subsequent changes		

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- 1 in status may be made pursuant to applicable civil service and
- 2 compensation laws.
- 3 An officer or employee of the State who does not have
- 4 tenure and who may be transferred or appointed to a civil
- 5 service position as a consequence of this Act shall become a
- 6 civil service employee without the loss of salary, seniority,
- 7 prior service credit, vacation, sick leave, or other employee
- 8 benefits or privileges and without the necessity of examination;
- 9 provided that such officer or employee possesses the minimum
- 10 qualifications for the position to which transferred or
- 11 appointed.
- 12
 If an office or position held by an officer or employee
- 13 having tenure is abolished, the officer or employee shall not
- 14 thereby be separated from public employment, but shall remain in
- 15 the employment of the State with the same pay and classification
- 16 and shall be transferred to some other office or position for
- 17 which the officer or employee is eligible under the personnel
- 18 laws of the State as determined by the head of the department or
- 19 the governor.
- 20 SECTION 4. All appropriations, records, equipment,
- 21 machines, files, supplies, contracts, books, papers, documents,



- 1 maps, and other personal property heretofore made, used,
- 2 acquired, or held by the department of land and natural
- 3 resources relating to the functions transferred to the office of
- 4 planning and sustainable development shall be transferred with
- 5 the functions to which they relate.
- 6 SECTION 5. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 7 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 8 SECTION 6. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
