A BILL FOR AN ACT

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. The legislature finds that pesticide
applications occurring near schools need to be further studied
to ensure Hawaii's children are not being impacted by off-target
pesticide drift.

5 The legislature also finds that the department of 6 agriculture has initiated a study on pesticide drift for schools 7 statewide. The legislature recognizes the importance of this 8 project to ensure children's safety and appropriate uses of 9 pesticides for agricultural food security.

10 Accordingly, the purpose of this Act is to appropriate 11 funds for the continued monitoring of pesticide drift in schools 12 statewide.

SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the pesticide use revolving fund the sum of \$323,484 or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2025-2026 and the sum of \$311,903 or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2026-2027,
