BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- SECTION 1. Section 163D-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is

 amended by adding a new definition to be appropriately inserted

 and to read as follows:

 ""Agricultural tourism" means commercial activity conducted
- 5 on a working farm, or a farming operation as defined in section
- 6 165-2, for the enjoyment, education, or involvement of visitors;
- 7 provided that the agricultural tourism activity is accessory and
- 8 secondary to the principal agricultural use and does not
- 9 interfere with surrounding farm operations."
- 10 SECTION 2. Section 163D-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 11 amended by amending the definition of "enterprise" to read as
- 12 follows:
- ""Enterprise" means a business with its principal place of
- 14 business in Hawaii, which is, or proposes to be, engaged in
- 15 agricultural crop development, development of new value-added
- 16 products, enhancement of existing agricultural commodities, and
- 17 the application of existing agricultural appurtenant facilities
- 18 to productive uses; provided that the majority of whatever the

TITLE: A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO THE

PURPOSE: To include agricultural tourism in the

definition of "enterprise" to authorize the Agribusiness Development Corporation to financially support farming businesses

engaged in agricultural tourism.

MEANS: Add a new definition to section 163D-2,

Hawaii Revised Statutes (HRS) and amend the definition of "enterprise" in section 163D-

2, HRS.

JUSTIFICATION: Agricultural tourism is a powerful direct-

marketing strategy that strengthens consumer transparency and helps reconstruct the relationship between consumers and food, while being economically beneficial for local producers. This bill would allow the use of the funds in the Hawaii Agricultural Development Revolving Fund for the financial

support of farming businesses engaged in

agricultural tourism.

Impact on the public: The promotion of agricultural tourism in the State will foster greater transparency in food consumption for consumers while allowing farmers to capitalize on alternative revenue streams to bolster their main responsibility

of food production.
