A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE SMALL BUSINESS REGULATORY REVIEW BOARD.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Section 201M-5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended by amending subsection (d) to read as follows:

"(d) A majority of all the members [~~to which the board is entitled~~] currently serving on the board shall constitute a quorum to do business, and the concurrence of a majority of all the members [~~to which the board is entitled~~] currently serving on the board shall be necessary to make any action of the board valid[-]; provided that at least five members are necessary to constitute a quorum to do business and validate any action of the board."

SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.

JUSTIFICATION SHEET

DEPARTMENT: Business, Economic Development, and Tourism

TITLE: A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO THE SMALL
BUSINESS REGULATORY REVIEW BOARD.

PURPOSE: To amend the quorum requirements to do
business and validate acts of the Small
Business Regulatory Review Board (SBRRB) to
account for vacancies.

MEANS: Amend section 201M-5(d), Hawaii Revised
Statutes (HRS).

JUSTIFICATION: The SBRRB has had trouble meeting current
quorum requirements due to vacancies. This
bill will allow a majority of the SBRRB's
currently appointed members to constitute a
quorum to do business and take official
action.

Impact on the public: Authorizing business
to be conducted and actions to be validated
by the majority of actual members will allow
the SBRRB to function without interruption
and thus benefit small business owners.

Impact on the department and other agencies:
Having a flexible quorum requirement that
accounts for vacancies will reduce potential
delays in the rulemaking process caused by
meeting cancellations due to a lack of
quorum.
