# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO TITLE 24, HAWAII REVISED STATUTES.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 432:1-407, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended by amending subsection (g) to read as follows: 2 "(q) Each domestic mutual benefit society shall prepare 3 and submit for review by the commissioner on or before the 4 forty-fifth day [of] after each [quarter,] of the first three 5 6 calendar quarters, and for the fourth calendar quarter ending 7 December 31, on or before the next March 1, a copy of its quarterly net solvency report verified by at least two principal 8 9 officers. The commissioner may prescribe the forms on which the 10 reports are to be prepared. Each domestic mutual benefit 11 society shall maintain a copy of its current net solvency report 12 on the premises of its primary place of business. The commissioner may order an examination, subject to article 2 of 13 chapter 431, to determine whether a domestic mutual benefit 14 15 society is in compliance with this section. Any domestic mutual 16 benefit society that fails or refuses to prepare or [produce] 17 submit for review the quarterly net solvency report as required

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1 by this subsection shall be liable for a penalty in an amount 2 not less than \$100 and not more than \$500 per day." 3 SECTION 2. Section 432D-8, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 4 amended by amending subsection (q) to read as follows: 5 "(q) Each health maintenance organization shall prepare 6 and submit for review by the commissioner on or before the 7 forty-fifth day [of] after each [quarter,] of the first three calendar quarters, and for the fourth calendar quarter ending 8 9 December 31, on or before the next March 1, a copy of its 10 quarterly net solvency report verified by at least two principal 11 officers. The commissioner may prescribe the forms on which the 12 reports are to be prepared. Every health maintenance 13 organization shall maintain a copy of its current net solvency report on the premises of its primary place of business. 14 The 15 commissioner may order an examination, subject to article 2 of 16 chapter 431, to determine whether a health maintenance 17 organization is in compliance with this section. Any health 18 maintenance organization that fails or refuses to prepare or 19 [produce] submit for review the quarterly net solvency report as 20 required by this subsection shall be liable for a penalty in an amount not less than \$100 and not more than \$500 per day." 21

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1 SECTION 3. Section 432G-6, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended by amending subsections (g) and (h) to read as follows: 2 3 Each dental insurer shall prepare and submit for "(q) review by the commissioner on or before the forty-fifth day  $[\frac{\partial f}{\partial f}]$ 4 5 after each [quarter,] of the first three calendar quarters, and 6 for the fourth calendar quarter ending December 31, on or before 7 the next March 1, a copy of its quarterly net solvency report 8 verified by at least two principal officers. The commissioner 9 may prescribe the forms on which the reports are to be 10 prepared. Every dental insurer shall maintain a copy of its 11 current net solvency report on the premises of its primary place 12 of business.

(h) The commissioner may order an examination, subject to article 2 of chapter 431, to determine whether a dental insurer is in compliance with this section. Any dental insurer that fails or refuses to prepare or [produce] submit for review the quarterly net solvency report or any of the documents as required by this section shall be liable for a penalty pursuant to section 432G-4(c)."

20 SECTION 4. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed21 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

Provides amendments to net solvency report filing requirements for mutual benefit societies, dental insurers, and health maintenance organizations. Effective 10/1/2025.

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#### JUSTIFICATION SHEET

DEPARTMENT: Commerce and Consumer Affairs

- TITLE: A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO TITLE 24, HAWAII REVISED STATUTES.
- PURPOSE: To change the filing dates of quarterly net solvency reports for mutual benefit societies, health maintenance organizations, and dental insurers so that the fourth quarter filing deadline falls on March 1 of the next year.
- MEANS: Amend sections 432:1-407(g), 432D-8(g), and 432G-6(g) and (h), Hawaii Revised Statutes (HRS).
- JUSTIFICATION: Currently, fourth quarter net solvency reports for mutual benefit societies, health maintenance organizations are due on February 14, while annual blank filings are due March 1.

<u>Impact on the public:</u> Aligning the due dates for fourth quarter net solvency reports for mutual benefit societies, health maintenance organizations, and dental insurers with the due date for annual blank filings will allow these entities, from whom the public obtains coverage, to more efficiently complete the relevant filings, thereby reducing their compliance burden.

Impact on the department and other agencies: This bill will allow the Department to more efficiently regulate mutual benefit societies, health maintenance organizations, and dental insurers.
