A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EDUCATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that teachers understand 2 their students' needs and tailor their classrooms to create an 3 engaging and effective learning experience. Nationwide, 4 teachers spend an average of five hundred dollars out-of-pocket 5 on their classrooms each year. To alleviate the financial burden on teachers, the department of education is committed to 6 7 providing funding for teacher-requested classroom supplies. 8 The purpose of this Act is to appropriate funds to the 9 department of education for teacher-requested classroom 10 supplies. The department of education intends to engage in 11 public-private partnerships focused on leveraging existing 12 financial resources from both sectors, to provide teachers and 13 students with project-based resources.

SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2025-2026 and the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal

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year 2026-2027 to carry out the purposes of this Act, including
providing for teacher-requested classroom supplies.

3 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department4 of education for the purposes of this Act.

5 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
