A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII CONFERENCE CENTER REVOLVING FUND.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 304A, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by adding to part V, subpart D, a new section to be
3	appropriately designated and to read as follows:
4	"§304A- University of Hawaii conference center
5	revolving fund. (a) There is established the university of
6	Hawaii conference center revolving fund for conference center
7	programs conducted by the university. The university may
8	establish and collect fees and charges for the costs of
9	providing these services. All fees, charges, and other moneys
10	collected in conjunction with the conference center programs of
11	the university shall be deposited in separate accounts within
12	the revolving fund. The university may establish accounts under
13	the university of Hawaii conference center revolving fund to
14	facilitate the administration of this fund among the various
15	campuses and operating units of the university of Hawaii system.
16	The university is authorized to expend funds from the
17	appropriate account in the revolving fund for all costs

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provided by the conference center programs, including but not 2 3 limited to expenses for honoraria, hotel and room rentals, food and refreshment, printing and mailing, airfare and per diem, 4 lei, rental of audiovisual equipment, and other conference 5 6 related services, fees, supplies and materials, without regard 7 to section 103D-1002 and any competitive bidding requirements 8 pursuant to state procurement requirements. 9 (b) The university shall prepare an annual report to the legislature accounting for all income and expenditures of each 10 separate account within the revolving fund." 11 SECTION 2. Section 304A-2272, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 12 13 repealed. 14 ["§304A-2272 Conference center revolving fund; University 15 of Hawaii at Hilo. (a) There is established the conference 16 center revolving fund for conference center programs conducted by the University of Hawaii at Hilo. All fees, charges, and **17** other moneys collected in conjunction with conference center 18 19 programs shall be deposited in the revolving fund. The **20** chancellor of the University of Hawaii at Hilo or the 21 chancellor's designee is authorized to expend funds from the revolving fund for all costs associated with conferences, 22

associated with conducting conferences, seminars, and courses

1 seminars, and courses provided by conference center programs, 2 including but not limited to expenses for honoraria, hotel and 3 room rentals, food and refreshment, printing and mailing, airfare and per diem, lei, rental of audiovisual equipment, and 4 5 conference supplies and materials, without regard to any 6 competitive bidding requirements pursuant to chapter 103D. 7 (b) The chancellor of the University of Hawaii at Hilo 8 shall submit a report to the legislature no later than twenty 9 days prior to the convening of each regular session that 10 includes an accounting for all income and expenditures of the revolving fund under this section."] 11 **12** SECTION 3. Section 304A-2273, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 13 repealed. 14 ["[§304A-2273] Community college conference center 15 revolving fund. (a) There is established the community college 16 conference center revolving fund for conference center programs **17** conducted by the various community colleges. All fees, charges, and other moneys collected in conjunction with the conference 18 19 center program of each community college shall be deposited in separate accounts within the revolving fund. The chancellor of 20 21 each community college or a designee is authorized to expend 22 funds from the appropriate account in the revolving fund for all

1 costs associated with conducting conferences, seminars, and 2 courses by the conference center program, including but not 3 limited to expenses for honoraria, hotel and room rentals, food 4 and refreshment, printing and mailing, airfare and per diem, 5 leis, rental of audiovisual equipment, and conference supplies 6 and materials, without regard to section 103D-1002 and any 7 competitive bidding requirements pursuant to state procurement 8 requirements. 9 (b) The chancellors of the community colleges shall 10 prepare an annual report to the legislature accounting for all 11 income and expenditures of each separate account within the 12 revolving fund."] 13 SECTION 4. On July 1, 2025, all appropriations and 14 encumbrances in the conference center revolving fund, university 15 of Hawaii at Hilo, and in the community college conference 16 center revolving fund shall be transferred to the university of 17 Hawaii conference center revolving fund. 18 SECTION 5. There is appropriated out of the university of 19 Hawaii conference center revolving fund the sum of \$ or 20 so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2025-2026. 21 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the university of 22 Hawaii for purposes of this Act.

Repeals the Conference Center Revolving Fund, University of Hawaii at Hilo, and the Community College Conference Center Revolving Fund. Transfers all appropriations and encumbrances of the Conference Center Revolving Fund, University of Hawaii at Hilo, and the Community College Conference Center Revolving Fund to the University of Hawaii Conference Center Revolving Fund.

to implement these programs while simultaneously eliminating unnecessary

duplication of statutes.
