# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HISTORIC PRESERVATION.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 6E-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by amending the definition of "historic property" to 3 read as follows: 4 ""Historic property" means any building, structure, object, 5 district, area, or site, including heiau and underwater site[7 6 which is] that is over fifty years old[-] and meets the criteria 7 for being entered into the Hawaii register of historic places." 8 SECTION 2. Section 6E-42.2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 9 amended to read as follows: 10 "[+]\$6E-42.2[+] Excluded activities for privately-owned 11 single-family detached dwelling units and townhouses [-], 12 residential projects, and nominally sensitive areas. (a) An 13 application for a proposed project on an existing privately-14 owned single-family detached dwelling unit or townhouse shall be 15 subject to the requirements of section 6E-42 only if the single-16 family detached dwelling unit or townhouse is over fifty years **17** old and:

- 10 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 11 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 12 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 3000.

### Report Title:

Historic Preservation; Historic Property

### Description:

Amends the definition of "historic property" to require that the property is over 50 years old and meets the criteria for inclusion in the Hawaii Register of Historic Places. Excludes proposed projects on existing residential property and proposed projects that are in nominally sensitive areas from the State's Historic Preservation Program review, under certain circumstances. Effective 7/1/3000. (HD1)

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
