## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO AIR CARRIERS.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that since January 2021,

2 only one passenger airline has provided service to the general

3 public out of Molokai Airport. While the airline has done its

4 best to accommodate the needs of passengers, including adding

5 additional routes and flight times and ordering larger planes,

6 the cost of plane tickets remains a hindrance to many Molokai

7 residents who need to travel for essential reasons, including

8 work, medical appointments, and family.

9 The legislature further finds that alleviating the costs of

10 air travel, primarily for small, rural communities reliant on

11 air travel for essential services and other needs, is a public

12 purpose; and encouraging additional airlines to provide reliable

airline services to and from Molokai to assist the residents who

14 need to travel for essential reasons is a public purpose. The

15 legislature recognizes that providing a subsidy can help

16 airlines offset the cost of passenger tickets while encouraging

17 other airlines to also provide service at Molokai Airport.

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1 Accordingly, the purpose of this Act is to require the 2 department of transportation to establish a Molokai air carrier 3 subsidy program to provide subsidies to airlines operating out 4 of Molokai Airport. 5 SECTION 2. Chapter 261E, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated 6 7 and to read as follows: 8 "\$261E- Molokai air carrier subsidy program. (a) There 9 is established within the department of transportation the 10 Molokai air carrier subsidy program to provide subsidies to air 11 carriers operating out of Molokai Airport. 12 (b) The Molokai air carrier subsidy program shall provide state subsidies to qualified applicants pursuant to the 13 14 following terms, conditions, and standards: Any subsidy shall be used exclusively for the purposes 15 (1) 16 of the program; The applicant shall indicate the capability to 17 (2) properly use the subsidy for the costs of operation in 18 19 and out of Molokai Airport; The applicant shall comply with all applicable federal 20 (3)

and state laws prohibiting discrimination against any

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1		person on the basis of race, color, national origin,
2		religion, creed, sex, age, sexual orientation,
3		disability, or any other characteristic protected
4		under applicable federal or state law;
5	(4)	The subsidy shall not be used for purposes of
6		entertainment or perquisites;
7	(5)	All activities undertaken with subsidy funds received
8		shall comply with all applicable federal, state, and
9		county statutes and ordinances;
10	<u>(6)</u>	The applicant shall:
11		(A) Indemnify and hold harmless the State and its
12		officers, agents, and employees from and against
13		any and all claims arising out of or resulting
14		from activities carried out or projects
15		undertaken with funds received from the program;
16		and
17		(B) Obtain sufficient insurance to provide the
18		indemnification under subparagraph (A), if
19		requested to do so by the department;
20	<u>(7)</u>	The applicant shall agree to make available to the
21		department of transportation all records the applicant

1		may have relating to the subsidy to monitor the	
2		applicant's compliance with the requirements of the	
3		program; and	
4	(8)	The applicant shall comply with other requirements as	
5		the department may prescribe.	
6	(C)	The department shall submit an annual report to the	
7	legislature regarding the program, including subsidy funds		
8	disbursed	and detailed accounting and descriptions of	
9	expenditures of subsidy funds, no later than twenty days prior		
10	to the convening of each regular session.		
11	<u>(d)</u>	As used in this section:	
12	<u>"App</u>	licant" means a qualified air carrier operating, or	
13	planning	to operate, out of Molokai Airport seeking a subsidy.	
14	"Dep	artment" means the department of transportation.	
15	"Pro	gram" means the Molokai air carrier subsidy program.	
16	<u>"Sub</u>	sidy" means the sum of money appropriated by the	
17	legislatu	re to the department to be disbursed to qualified air	
18	carriers operating out of Molokai airport."		
19	SECT	ION 3. In establishing the Molokai air carrier subsidy	
20	program pursuant to section 2 of this Act, the department of		
21	transport	ation shall request the assistance of Hawaii's	

- 1 congressional delegation, the Federal Aviation Administration,
- 2 and other pertinent federal officials.
- 3 SECTION 4. There is appropriated out of the general
- 4 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
- 5 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2025-2026 and
- 6 the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
- 7 year 2026-2027 for the Molokai air carrier subsidy program.
- 8 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
- 9 of transportation for the purposes of this Act.
- 10 SECTION 5. New statutory material is underscored.
- 11 SECTION 6. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
