A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO INSURANCE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- SECTION 1. Chapter 431:14G, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
 and to read as follows:

 "S431:14G- Contracts; physicians; fee for service

 plans. Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, after

 December 31, 2025, each new or renewed contract between a mutual
- 7 benefit society and a physician for a fee for service plan shall
- 8 provide for:
- 9 (1) The reimbursement of the physician's increased
 10 overhead costs, cost of living increases, and
 11 increased costs caused by inflation; and
- 12 (2) An increase of ten per cent in the rate for
 13 reimbursement of services after each five-year period
 14 that the physician is in service."
- 15 SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that 16 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were 17 begun before its effective date.

Report Title:

Insurance; Physicians; Contracts; Fee for Service Plans; Reimbursement

Description:

Provides that after 12/31/2025, each new or renewed contract between a mutual benefit society and a physician for a fee for service plan shall provide for: (1) The reimbursement of the physician's increased overhead costs, cost of living increases, and increased costs caused by inflation; and (2) An increase of 10% in the reimbursement rate of services after each 5-year period that the physician is in service.

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
