- 8 2027, 2028, and 2029. The task force shall submit a final

- 10 recommendations, and any proposed legislation, to the
- 11 legislature no later than twenty days prior to the convening of
- 12 the regular session of [2025.] 2030."

- "SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2023,
- 16 and shall be repealed on June 30, [2025] 2030."
