BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 704-404, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by amending subsection (11) to read as follows: 3 The compensation of persons making or assisting in "(11) 4 the examination, other than those retained by a nonindigent 5 defendant, who are not undertaking the examination upon 6 designation by the director of health as part of their normal 7 duties as employees of the State or a county, shall be paid by 8 the [State.] judiciary in the amount of \$2,000, which amount 9 includes compensation for the examination, the drafting of the 10 report, and any consultation, preparation, testimony, and 11 attendance in court." 12 SECTION 2. Section 704-407.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 13 amended by amending subsection (12) to read as follows:

14 "(12) The compensation of persons making or assisting in 15 the examination, other than those retained by a nonindigent 16 defendant, who are not undertaking the examination upon 17 designation by the director of health as part of their normal
