A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO FIREARMS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 134-8, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by amending subsection (c) to read as follows:
- 3 "(c) The manufacture, possession, sale, barter, trade,
- 4 gift, transfer, or acquisition of detachable ammunition
- 5 magazines with a capacity in excess of ten rounds [which] that
- 6 are designed for or capable of use with [a pistol] any firearm
- 7 is prohibited. This subsection shall not apply to magazines
- 8 originally designed to accept more than ten rounds of ammunition
- 9 [which] that have been modified to accept [no] not more than ten
- 10 rounds and which are not capable of being readily restored to a
- 11 capacity of more than ten rounds."
- 12 SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 13 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 14 begun before its effective date.
- 15 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 16 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 17 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on January 1, 2026.
