A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO MOPEDS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 286-81, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by amending subsection (b) as follows:
- 3 "(b) Notwithstanding subsection (a) and section 291C-195,
- 4 no person shall operate a moped or motor scooter leased from a
- 5 rental company on any roadway in the State unless the person
- 6 wears a safety helmet, which shall be provided by the rental
- 7 company unless the person provides the person's own safety
- 8 helmet; provided that this subsection shall not apply to persons
- 9 who possess a valid license under this chapter to operate a
- 10 motorcycle or an equivalent license issued from another state.
- 11 To meet the requirements of this subsection, the safety helmet
- 12 shall meet the specifications and requirements established by
- 13 rules adopted by the director."
- 14 SECTION 2. Section 291C-195, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 15 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:
- 16 "(a) Notwithstanding section 286-81(b), no person:

1	(1)	Less than [fifteen] sixteen years of age shall drive a
2		moped on a highway, street, roadway, or any other
3		public property in the State; and

- 4 (2) Less than [eighteen] twenty-one years of age shall
 5 drive a moped unless the person wears a safety helmet
 6 securely fastened with a chin strap.
- 7 The safety helmet shall meet the specifications and requirements
- 8 established by rules adopted by the director."
- 9 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 10 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 11 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 3000.
