A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO MOPEDS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 291C-195, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:
- 3 "(a) Notwithstanding section 286-81(b), no person[\div] less
- 4 than:
- 5 (1) [Less than fifteen] Sixteen years of age shall drive a
- 6 moped on a highway, street, or roadway, or any other
- 7 public property in the State; and
- **8** (2) [Less than eighteen] Twenty-one years of age shall
- 9 drive a moped unless the person wears a safety helmet
- 10 securely fastened with a chin strap.
- 11 The safety helmet shall meet the specifications and requirements
- 12 established by rules adopted by the director."
- 13 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 14 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 15 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 3000.

Prohibits persons under the age of sixteen from driving a moped and persons under the age of twenty-one from driving a moped without a helmet. Effective 7/1/3000. (HD2)
