BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

3	"(a) The manufacture, possession, sale, barter, trade,

8	eighteen inches; any firearm that is not a shotgun with the
9	capacity to fire ammunition of fifty caliber or higher; cannons;
10	mufflers, silencers, or devices for deadening or muffling the
11	sound of discharged firearms; hand grenades; dynamite, blasting
12	caps, bombs, or bombshells, or other explosives; or any type of
13	ammunition or any projectile component thereof coated with
14	[teflon] Teflon or any other similar coating designed primarily

to enhance its capability to penetrate metal or pierce

protective armor; and any type of ammunition or any projectile

- 1 component thereof designed or intended to explode or segment
- 2 upon impact with its target.
- For the purposes of this subsection:
- 4 "Firearm with the capacity to fire ammunition of fifty
- 5 caliber of higher" does not include antique pistols, antique
- 6 revolvers, or muzzleloaders.
- 7 "Muzzleloaders" means any rifle, pistol, or shotgun that
- 8 loads from the muzzle, or the open end of a weapon, from which
- 9 the ammunition is discharged."
- 10 SECTION 2. This Act shall not prohibit possession of a
- 11 firearm that is not a shotgun with the capacity to fire
- 12 ammunition of fifty caliber or higher that was legally obtained
- 13 prior to the effective date of this Act.
- 14 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 15 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

16 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on January 1, 2026.

Firearms; Gun Safety; High Caliber Guns

Description:

Includes any firearm with the capacity to fire ammunition of fifty caliber or higher, excluding antique pistols and revolvers, muzzleloaders, and shotguns, in the list of prohibited weapons. Exempts firearms with the capacity to fire ammunition of fifty caliber or higher legally obtained before 1/1/2026. Effective 1/1/2026. (SD2)
