A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO BUSINESS REGULATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 486, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by adding a new section to part V to be appropriately
- 3 designated and to read as follows:
- 4 "§486- Poi; labeling requirements. (a) If a product
- 5 labeled, marketed, or sold as "poi" contains ingredients wholly
- 6 grown in the State, the product shall bear a label stating that
- 7 the product is "100% Hawaii-grown."
- 8 (b) If a product labeled, marketed, or sold as "poi" contains
- 9 any ingredient grown outside the State, the product shall bear a
- 10 label stating: "This product contains ingredients grown outside
- 11 Hawaii."; provided that the label shall further identify the origin
- of the ingredients used in the product.
- (c) If this section or any provision of this section
- 14 conflicts at any time with federal law, then the federal law
- 15 shall prevail and this section or the relevant provisions of
- 16 this section shall become ineffective and invalid. The
- 17 ineffectiveness or invalidity of this section or any of its



- 1 provisions shall not affect any other provisions or applications
- 2 of this chapter which shall be given effect without the invalid
- 3 provision or application, and to this end, the provisions of
- 4 this section are severable.
- 5 (d) For the purposes of this section, "ingredient" means
- 6 something that enters into a compound or is a component part of
- 7 any combination or mixture."
- 8 SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.
- 9 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.

Requires any products labeled, marketed, or sold as "poi" to contain a label stating whether the poi product is made wholly ingredients grown in the State or from ingredients sourced outside the State. Effective 7/1/2050. (SD2)
