## SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF A PERPETUAL, NON-EXCLUSIVE EASEMENT COVERING A PORTION OF STATE SUBMERGED LANDS AT MAUNALUA, HONOLULU, OAHU, FOR THE STORMWATER MANAGEMENT OUTFALL AND DRAINAGE SYSTEM, AND FOR USE, REPAIR, AND MAINTENANCE OF THE IMPROVEMENTS CONSTRUCTED THEREON.

1 WHEREAS, portions of the existing drainage outfall fronting 2 the property identified as Tax Map Key: (1) 3-9-003: seaward of 3 028, Maunalua, Honolulu, Oahu, were placed on state submerged 4 lands; and 5

6 WHEREAS, on February 9, 2018, under agenda item K-3, the 7 Board of Land and Natural Resources approved the Office of 8 Conservation and Coastal Lands Conservation District Use Permit 9 for a permanent replacement of the drainage outfall that was 10 outdated and ineffective; and

WHEREAS, the City and County of Honolulu agreed to obtain an easement from the State for the portion of the stormwater management outfall and drainage system located on state submerged lands; and

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WHEREAS, under the same agenda item K-3 mentioned above,
the Board of Land and Natural Resources approved the grant of a
perpetual non-exclusive easement for the stormwater management
outfall and drainage system, at gratis consideration; and

WHEREAS, the total encroachment area was determined to be 1,050 square feet as reviewed and approved by the Department of Accounting and General Services Survey Division and 25

26 WHEREAS, section 171-53(c), Hawaii Revised Statutes,
27 requires the prior approval of the Governor and prior
28 authorization of the Legislature by concurrent resolution to
29 lease state submerged lands; now, therefore,

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BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirty-third 1 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2025, the 2 3 House of Representatives concurring, that the Board of Land and Natural Resources is hereby authorized to issue a perpetual, 4 non-exclusive easement covering a portion of state submerged 5 lands fronting the property identified as Tax Map Key: (1) 3-9-6 7 003: seaward of 028, Maunalua, Honolulu, Oahu, to the City and County of Honolulu for the stormwater management outfall and 8 drainage system, and for use, repair, and maintenance of the 9 improvements constructed thereon pursuant to section 171-53, 10 Hawaii Revised Statutes; and 11 12

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## JUSTIFICATION SHEET

DEPARTMENT: Land and Natural Resources

- TITLE: CONCURRENT RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF A PERPETUAL, NON-EXCLUSIVE EASEMENT COVERING A PORTION OF STATE SUBMERGED LANDS AT MAUNALUA, HONOLULU, OAHU, FOR THE STORMWATER MANAGEMENT OUTFALL AND DRAINAGE SYSTEM, AND FOR USE, REPAIR, AND MAINTENANCE OF THE IMPROVEMENTS CONSTRUCTED THEREON.
- PURPOSE: To seek the authorization of the Legislature by concurrent resolution of the issuance of a perpetual, non-exclusive easement by the Board of Land and Natural Resources (Board) for the stormwater management outfall and drainage system, and for use, repair, and maintenance of the existing improvements constructed thereon.
- MEANS: Concurrent resolution pursuant to section 171-53(c), Hawaii Revised Statutes (HRS).
- JUSTIFICATION: Portions of the existing drainage outfall seaward of the property identified as Tax Map Key: (1) 3-9-003: seaward of 028, Maunalua, Honolulu, Oahu, were placed on state submerged lands.

On February 9, 2018, the Board approved the Office of Conservation and Coastal Lands Conservation District Use Permit for a permanent replacement of the drainage outfall that was outdated and ineffective.

The City and County of Honolulu agreed to obtain an easement from the State for the portion of the stormwater management outfall and drainage system located on state submerged lands.

Under the same agenda item K-3 mentioned above, the Board approved the grant of a perpetual non-exclusive easement for the

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stormwater management outfall and drainage system, at gratis consideration.

The total encroachment area was determined to be 1,050 square feet as reviewed and approved by the Department of Accounting and General Services Survey Division.

Section 171-53(c), HRS, requires the prior approval of the Governor and prior authorization of the Legislature by concurrent resolution to lease state submerged lands. As such, this concurrent resolution has been prepared in compliance with the requirements of section 171-53(c), HRS.
