Your Committee reviewed the personal history, resume, and statement submitted by Forrest Wells for service on the State Council on Mental Health.

Your Committee received testimony in support of the nomination for the appointment of Forrest Wells from the Department of Health and one individual.

Upon review of the testimony, your Committee finds that Mr. Wells' experience, background, and commitment to public service qualify him for appointment to the State Council on Mental Health as a service provider member. Your Committee notes that Mr. Wells' has been a licensed mental health counselor for thirteen years. Mr. Wells is currently the Manager for Counseling Services at The Queen's Medical Center, where he provides clinical supervision for clinic providers and proposes programs to address mental health needs for residents in the State.
