Your Committee reviewed the personal history, resume, and statement submitted by Aileen Wada for service on the Hawaii Board of Veterinary Medicine.

Your Committee received testimony in support of the nomination for the reappointment of Aileen Wada from the Hawaii Board of Veterinary Medicine, Democratic Party of Hawaii, and one individual.

Upon review of the testimony, your Committee finds that Ms. Wada's experience, knowledge, and proven leadership on the Hawaii Board of Veterinary Medicine qualify her for reappointment to the Board as a public member. As a pet owner who has adopted rescued dogs, Ms. Wada bring a unique perspective that can be helpful in resolving issues considered by the Hawaii Board of Veterinary Medicine.
