Your Committee received testimony in support of the nomination for the appointment of Kimberly Thomson-Kerr from the Hawaii Board of Veterinary Medicine and two individuals.

Upon review of the testimony, your Committee finds that Dr. Thomson-Kerr's experience, background, and commitment to public service qualify her for appointment to the Hawaii Board of Veterinary Medicine as a licensed veterinarian member from Maui county.
