Your Committee on Conference on the disagreeing vote of the House of Representatives to the amendments proposed by the Senate in H.B. No. 1099, H.D. 1, S.D. 1, entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT MAKING AN EMERGENCY APPROPRIATION TO THE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SERVICES,"

having met, and after full and free discussion, has agreed to recommend and does recommend to the respective Houses the final passage of this bill in an amended form.

The purpose of this measure is to make an emergency appropriation for fiscal year 2024-2025 to the Department of Human Services to support the necessary modifications to the ongoing development of a new eligibility system that will assist in reducing the State's Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program payment error rate penalty.


- (1) Amending the amount and percentage of exceedance of the appropriation over the general fund expenditure ceiling for fiscal year 2024-2025; and


