Madame:

Your Committee on Finance, to which was referred H.B. No. 455, H.D. 1, entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO SMALL BUSINESS LOANS,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to:

- (1) Establish the Hawaii Start-Up Business Loan Program to encourage entrepreneurship, economic diversification, and resilience; and
- (2) Appropriate funds for the Hawaii Start-Up Business Loan Program and a Business Loan Officer position.

Your Committee received testimony in support of this measure from Holomua Collaborative; Mana Up; Hawai'i Community Foundation; aio; HPM Building Supply; Title Guaranty of Hawai'i; Chamber of Commerce Hawaii; Maui Chamber of Commerce; and Hawaii Food Industry Association. Your Committee received comments on this measure from the Department of Business, Economic Development, and Tourism; Department of Budget and Finance; Department of the Attorney General; and Tax Foundation of Hawaii.


Your Committee notes the concerns raised in testimony by the Department of the Attorney General regarding whether the



establishment of the Hawaii Start-Up Business Loan Program Special Fund satisfies the criteria for the establishment and continuation of special funds under section 37-52.3, Hawaii Revised Statutes.
