- (1) Establish a Cognitive Assessments for Medicare
  Beneficiaries Pilot Program within the Executive Office
  on Aging to provide certain Medicare Part B
  beneficiaries with a cognitive assessment for the early
  detection of dementia; and
- (2) Appropriate funds to the Executive Office on Aging for the costs associated with the data management and reporting requirements of the pilot program.
