Your Committee on Tourism, to which was referred H.C.R. No. 143 entitled:

"HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION STRONGLY URGING THE HAWAII TOURISM AUTHORITY TO REQUIRE ALL TRANSIENT ACCOMMODATIONS TO INCORPORATE THE PONO PLEDGE AS A REQUIREMENT FOR GUEST CHECK-IN,"

The purpose of this measure is to strongly urge the Hawaii Tourism Authority to require all transient accommodations to require guests to take the Pono Pledge upon check-in.

Your Committee has amended this measure by:

- (1)Strongly urging the Hawaii Tourism Authority to encourage, rather than require, all transient accommodations to require guests to take the Pono Pledge upon check-in; and
- (2)Changing the title of the measure accordingly.
