Your Committee on Finance, to which was referred S.B. No. 1120, S.D. 1, H.D. 1, entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO TRANSPORTATION,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to:

- Require the Department of Transportation to conduct a feasibility study on implementing a clean fuel standard for alternative fuels in the State; and
- (2) Require the Department of Transportation to adopt rules governing a clean fuel standard for alternative fuels in the State by January 1, 2028.

Your Committee received testimony in support of this measure from Clean Energy; Neste; NXTClean Fuels, Inc.; Low Carbon Fuels Coalition; EcoEngineers; Biotechnology Innovation Organization; Oberon Fuels; and two individuals. Your Committee received comments on this measure from the Department of Transportation; Twelve Benefit Corporation; Infinium Operations, LLC; Island Energy Services, LLC; Oahu Metropolitan Planning Organization; Amazon; Par Hawaii; Blue Planet Foundation; Alaska Airlines; Hawaiian Airlines; and Coalition Earth.
