Madame:

Your Committee on Transportation, to which was referred S.B. No. 1402, S.D. 1, entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO VESSELS IN STATE COMMERCIAL HARBORS,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to clarify and expand the requirements for the securing of mooring lines in state commercial harbors.

Your Committee received testimony in support of this measure from the General Contractors Association of Hawaii and Hawaii Longline Association. Your Committee received testimony in opposition to this measure from Holo Holo Charters, Inc.; and one individual.

Your Committee finds that this measure exempts government-owned or government-sponsored vessels, training vessels, and fishing vessels from the requirements that the securing of mooring lines from vessels to the State's commercial docks, wharves, piers, quays, and landings be performed by labor that is subject to collective bargaining.
