Your Committee on Health and Human Services, to which was referred S.B. No. 1564 entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO MEDICAID,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose and intent of this measure is to appropriate funds to the Department of Human Services to increase the funding of certain Medicaid home- and community-based services, including adult day programs and residential services offered in community care foster family homes and expanded adult residential care homes.

Your Committee received testimony in support of this measure from AARP Hawai'i and seven individuals.

Your Committee received comments on this measure from the Department of Human Services.

Your Committee finds that there is a strong demand for community-based care options for kupuna in the State since receiving care close to home makes it easier for kupuna to maintain connection with family and friends and continue to visit familiar health care providers. Your Committee further finds that community-based services providers face significant wage pressures when hiring registered nurses and certified nursing assistants and are competing with other facilities, which are reimbursed at

higher rates by Medicaid and private pay services for the same labor force. This measure increases the long-term care reimbursement rates from Medicaid to fund certain Medicaid homeand community-based services to attract, retain, and properly compensate the appropriate health care professionals so that they can continue to care for the State's most vulnerable populations, including kupuna.

Your Committee has amended this measure by:

- (1) Inserting an effective date of December 31, 2050, to encourage further discussion; and
- (2) Making technical, nonsubstantive amendments for the purposes of clarity and consistency.

Your Committee notes that this measure contains an unspecified appropriation amount. Should your Committee on Ways and Means choose to deliberate on this measure, your Committee respectfully requests that it consider inserting an appropriation amount that would total \$35,000,000, comprised of \$14,300,000 in state funds and \$20,700,000 in matching federal funds, to increase the funding of certain Medicaid home- and community-based services, including adult day programs and residential services offered in community care foster family homes and expanded adult residential care homes.

As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your Committee on Health and Human Services that is attached to this report, your Committee is in accord with the intent and purpose of S.B. No. 1564, as amended herein, and recommends that it pass Second Reading in the form attached hereto as S.B. No. 1564, S.D. 1, and be referred to your Committee on Ways and Means.
