Your Committee on Transportation, to which was referred
S.C.R. No. 200, S.D. 1, entitled:

"SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE OAHU
METROPOLITAN PLANNING ORGANIZATION TO CONTINUE TRANSPORTATION
MANAGEMENT TRAINING PROGRAMS THAT FOCUS ON EDUCATING KEY
DECISION MAKERS RESPONSIBLE FOR TRANSPORTATION POLICY,
PLANNING, FUNDING, AND IMPLEMENTATION,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to request the Oahu
Metropolitan Planning Organization to continue transportation
management training programs that focus on educating key decision
makers responsible for transportation policy, planning, funding,
and implementation.

Your Committee received testimony in support of this measure
from the Oahu Metropolitan Planning Organization and one
individual.

Your Committee finds that Hawaii faces high transportation
costs per capita and disproportionately high rates of
transportation-related fatalities and injuries. These challenges
are compounded by fragmented governance across multiple agencies,
making cohesive, effective implementation difficult. This measure
supports continued training programs by the Oahu Metropolitan
