SB 1343, SD1 (SSCR1065) RELATING TO THE SMALL BUSINESS REGULATORY REVIEW ECD, JHA

BOARD.

Status Amends the quorum requirements to do business and validate acts of

the Small Business Regulatory Review Board. Effective 7/1/2050.

SB 1578, SD2 (SSCR841) Status RELATING TO INTERNATIONAL AFFAIRS.

ECD, FIN

Establishes the Hawaii Sister-State and International Partnerships Commission. Requires the Office of International Affairs to provide support to the Hawaii Sister-State and International Partnerships Commission. Allows the Department of Business, Economic Development, and Tourism to establish out-of-state offices and facilities to support sister-state and other partnerships that promote and enrich the people, cultures, environments, and economies of the State and its international partners, generate revenue for the State, and buy

property. Appropriates funds. Effective 7/1/2050. (SD2)

SB 1641, SD2 (SSCR983) Status RELATING TO THE STATE OF HAWAII FILM COMMISSION.

ECD, FIN

Establishes the State of Hawaii Film Commission within the Department of Business, Economic Development, and Tourism to support the State's film industries. Establishes the State of Hawaii Film Commission Board within the State of Hawaii Film Commission. Requires investment revenues and returns from made and fees and charges collected by the State of Hawaii Film Commission to be deposited into the Film Industry Development Special Fund. Makes conforming amendments to the Hawaii Film and Creative Industries Development Special Fund. Allows the Department to use the film fund to provide the support and development of facilities, film tax incentives, and other initiatives to grow the State's film industries. Requires annual reports to the Legislature. Appropriates funds.

Effective 7/1/2050. (SD2)

SB 1038, SD1 (SSCR800) Status RELATING TO PRIVACY.

Adds definitions of "identifier" and "specified data element" and amends the definition of "personal information" for the purposes of notifying affected persons of data and security breaches under existing state law that governs the security breach of personal information. Includes licensees subject to the Insurance Data Security Law among

the businesses deemed compliant with security breach notice requirements under existing state law. Effective 7/1/2050. (SD1)

SB 1043, SD2 (SSCR924) Status RELATING TO TAXATION.

Exempts the sale of groceries and nonprescription drugs from the

general excise tax. Effective 12/31/2050. (SD2)

DECISION MAKING TO FOLLOW
