SB 1656 Status & Testimony	RELATING TO PUMPED STORAGE HYDROPOWER. Authorizes the issuance of general obligation bonds to the Department of Hawaiian Home Lands to finance the planning, designing, and construction of a water pump storage hydroelectric facility in the Kohala Mountains on Hawaii Island.
