RELATING TO NEPOTISM. SB 1545 LMG, JHA

(SSCR698) Repeals language in the State's Code of Ethics that exempts the <u>Status</u>

Legislative Branch from prohibitions against nepotism in public

employment.

DECISION MAKING TO FOLLOW
