duty for more than 30 days.

HB 1058 Status	RELATING TO VETERANS CEMETERIES. Establishes the Veterans Cemeteries Board within the Office of Veterans Services of the Department of Defense to provide veterans cemeteries in the State with guidance, education, technical assistance, and other support to ensure compliance with standards set by the National Cemetery Administration of the United States Department of Veterans Affairs. HB 503 Status	RELATING TO THE HAWAII FIRST RESPONDERS MEMORIAL. Appropriates funds to the Department of Accounting and General Services to hire a consultant to evaluate potential locations and designs for the Hawaii First Responders Memorial.	PBS, FIN
