SB 820 Status & Testimony	RELATING TO VEHICLE TITLES. Reduces the period in which a transferee is required to forward the certificate of ownership to the director of finance when a title of vehicle is transferred from thirty days to fourteen days. Allows a letter of attestation to the Director of Finance to act as an endorsed certificate for motor vehicle transfer.	TCA, JDC
SB 1095 Status & Testimony	RELATING TO LICENSE PLATES. Removes the decal size restrictions for special number plates.	TCA
SB 215 Status & Testimony	RELATING TO TOWING COMPANIES. Changes the fees that a towing company may charge to tow vehicles left unattended on private and public property. Allows a towing company or parking management company to charge a fee for the placement or removal of vehicle immobilization devices. Requires that fees for the placement or removal of vehicle immobilization devices be accepted from a vehicle owner in cash, or by credit card or debit card, and a vehicle owner shall not be directed to use an on-site automated teller machine in lieu of making payment by credit card or debit card. SB 367 Status & Testimony	RELATING TO TRANSPORTATION. Prohibits the issuance of a certificate of inspection for a moped or motor vehicle that has been altered, installed, or otherwise	TCA, JDC
