Repeals the requirement that a portion of the fees collected for certified copies of certain certificates issued by the Department of Health be deposited to the credit of the general fund. Establishes the Universal Immunization Funding Program for the purpose of administering immunizations to individuals in the State who are not eligible to receive immunizations at no cost through other programs. Establishes the Universal

Immunization Purchase Special Fund into which fees will be deposited to finance the Universal Immunization Funding

RELATING TO THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH. **SB 1443, SD1** HHS, WAM Establishes maximum rates of payment for medical care for (SSCR331) patients of the Hawaii State Hospital or of another psychiatric facility who are under the custody of the Director of Health. Status & Authorizes the Department of Health to establish long-term care Testimony payment rates for patients discharged to a long-term care facility from the Hawaii State Hospital or another psychiatric facility where they were under the custody of the Director of Health. Exempts the Department of Health from chapter 103F, HRS, for the procurement of medical care and long-term care for patients who are or were under the custody of the Director of Health at the Hawaii State Hospital or a psychiatric facility. Effective 7/31/2050. (SD1) **SB 1612, SD1** RELATING TO FITNESS TO PROCEED. PSM/HHS. WAM Requires and appropriates funds for the Department of (SSCR281) Corrections and Rehabilitation, in collaboration with the Department of Health, to establish and implement a 5-year Status & Fitness to Proceed Pilot Program. Requires an interim report **Testimony** and final report to the Legislature. Effective 7/1/2077. (SD1)
