HB 505, HD1 (HSCR1152) Status & Testimony	RELATING TO RED HILL. Establishes a WAI Policy Coordinator for coordination of Red Hill WAI initiatives. Creates the Red Hill Remediation Special Fund. Effective 7/1/3000. (HD1)	WTL/AEN, WAM
HB 778, HD2 (HSCR1032) Status & Testimony	RELATING TO INTEGRATED LAND USE. Requires the Office of Planning and Sustainable Development to conduct an integrated land use study for the use of lands within the agricultural districts and submit interim and final reports to the Legislature. Appropriates funds. Effective 7/1/3000. (HD2)	WTL/AEN, WAM
HB 1220, HD1 (HSCR977) Status & Testimony	RELATING TO INVASIVE SPECIES. Appropriates funds to support the efforts of the Division of Aquatic Resources of the Department of Land and Natural Resources in the removal of the majano anemone from Kaneohe Bay. Effective 7/1/3000. (HD1)	WTL/AEN, WAM
