HB130 RELATING TO FEES FOR PUBLIC RECORDS UNDER

CHAPTER 92F.

Imposes a cap on charges for searching for, reviewing, and segregating government records under the Uniform Information

Practices Act. Provides for a waiver of fees in certain circumstances when the public interest is served by a

government record's disclosure.
