SR 140 / SCR 171 DOH to Adopt Rules to Permit Restaurants to Allow Dogs

The Hawaii Restaurant Association, representing 4,000 plus eating and drinking places, supports the intent of SR 140 that request the Department of Health to adopt rules for restaurants to allow dogs in designated areas of their establishments while adhering to Health and Safety regulations.

We recommend that the following conditions are spelled out.

- It is the owner of the restaurant owner's decision to allow dogs in the restaurant.
- Pet dogs are only allowed in outdoor dining areas. 2.
- Pet dog must be on a leash or confined in a pet carrier under owner's control 3. at all times
- Pet dogs are not allowed on seats, benches or tables. 4.
