Executive Summary – December 2024

- On December 9, 2024, the RSM team presented a demo of the functionality developed in Iteration 1. This was very well received by the provider audience, and the deliverable was approved by DOH.
- IV&V is still in process of reviewing the expected Requirements, User Stories, testing activities and results, and other associated documentation for Iteration 1 to ensure that the delivered functionality meets the expectations of DOH. This was delayed while access to the information was provided to IV&V. We had only minor questions after the initial demo.
