#### REPORT TO THE LEGISLATURE

Hawai'i Cancer Research Special Fund July 1 – December 31, 2023

Section 304A-2168, Hawai'i Revised Statutes, establishes the Hawai'i Cancer Research Special Fund within the state treasury; requires that the moneys in the fund be used for the research and operating expenses and capital expenditures of the University of Hawai'i Cancer Center (formerly known as the Cancer Research Center of Hawai'i); and requires that, beginning on January 1, 2010, the University of Hawai'i shall report semi-annually to the Legislature on the moneys in the fund, including deposits, expenditures, and other transactions.

The University of Hawai'i Cancer Center was established in 1971 and is the only National Cancer Institute-designated cancer center in Hawai'i and the Pacific. The Center's mission is to reduce the burden of cancer through research, education, patient care, and community outreach, with an emphasis on the unique ethnic, cultural, and environmental characteristics of Hawai'i and the Pacific.

Personnel	3,434,255	Research and operating expenditures: salary support for faculty, researchers, graduate assistants, admin staff. Cost adjustment due to the use of an alternate funding source.
Services – Fee Basis	117,251	Research and operating expenditures: lab services, facility maintenance & inspection services, and RCUH service fees. Cost adjustments due to the use of an alternate funding source.
Materials & Supplies	160,610	Research and operating expenditures: lab, office, and facilities/maintenance supplies
Travel & Faculty Relocations	97,691	Research and operating expenditures: travel expenses for faculty. Cost adjustment due to the use of an alternate funding source.
