A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO WATER POLLUTION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Section 200-14, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended to read as follows:

3 "§200-14 Violation of chapter or rules; penalty. (a) Any 4 person who violates any provision in this chapter, or rule 5 adopted by the department, relating to boating accidents, 6 reckless or unauthorized operation of a vessel, unauthorized 7 mooring of a vessel, unauthorized commercial activity, 8 unauthorized camping within state small boat harbors or boating 9 facilities, animal abandonment within state small boat harbors 10 or boating facilities, or creation of animal colonies within 11 state small boat harbors or boating facilities shall be quilty 12 of a petty misdemeanor and shall be fined not more than \$1,000. 13 Any person who violates any rule adopted by the (b) 14 department under this part regulating vehicular parking or traffic movement shall have committed a traffic infraction as 15 16 set forth in chapter 291D, the adjudication of which shall be

subject to the provisions contained [therein.] in chapter 291D.

(d) (c) As a condition of probation pursuant to sections 1 2 706-623 and 706-624, or as a condition to the suspension of any 3 criminal penalties, the environmental court may provide that the 4 defendant refrain from operating any vessel, including but not 5 limited to any thrill craft or vessel engaged in parasailing or 6 water sledding, in specified geographical areas of the waters of 7 the State. 8 [(c)] (d) For the purposes of this section, "operate", 9 "parasailing", "thrill craft", "vessel", "water sledding", and 10 "waters of the State" have the same meaning as those terms are defined in section 200-23." 11 12 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed and stricken. New statutory material is underscored. 13 14 SECTION 3. The Act shall take effect upon its approval.
