BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 342D-50.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended to read as follows: 3 "[[]§342D-50.5[] Treated] Wastewater or raw sewage; 4 prohibition. (a) Notwithstanding any other law to the 5 contrary, no person[, including any public body,] or treatment 6 plant shall discharge any [treated] wastewater or raw sewage 7 into state waters after December 31, 2026; provided that this 8 section shall not apply to a [sewage] person or treatment plant 9 that[+ 10 (1) Utilizes sewage to produce clean energy pursuant to section 196-10.5; and 11 12 (2) Is in compliance with this chapter, rules adopted 13 pursuant to this chapter, or a permit or variance 14 issued by the director. 15 (b) Nothing in this section shall be construed to: 16 (1) Prohibit the use of reclaimed or recycled water for a 17 beneficial purpose as provided by law; or

1 (2) Allow the discharge of [treated] wastewater or raw 2 sewage into state waters in violation of any federal 3 statute, rule, or regulation." SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that 4 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were 5 begun before its effective date. 6 7 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed and stricken. New statutory material is underscored. 8

9 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
