Section 205A-22, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by amending the definitions of "special management area minor permit" and "special management area use permit" to read 3 4 as follows: ""Special management area minor permit" means an action by 5 6 the authority authorizing development [the valuation of which is not in excess of \$500,000 and which] that has no substantial 7 adverse environmental or ecological effect, taking into account 8 potential cumulative effects [-], and the valuation of which is 9 10 not in excess of:
