A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO APPROPRIATIONS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. The legislature finds that for fiscal year
 2025, the executive branch had requested about \$3,600,000,000 in
 funding for more than forty-seven thousand permanent and three
 thousand six hundred temporary authorized positions. The amount
 requested accounted for more than twenty per cent of all
 authorized funds in fiscal year 2025.

7 The legislature further finds that there has been a high 8 vacancy rate in public employment positions and funds 9 appropriated for these positions are either transferred or used . 10 for purposes that are not consistent with the purpose for which 11 the appropriation was authorized. A vacancy report from 12 December 2024 from the department of human resources development 13 identified four thousand eighty-five vacancies, or about twenty-14 four per cent of civil service positions, in the State.

15 The purpose of this Act is to increase legislative
16 oversight to ensure that funds appropriated by the legislature
17 are used for their intended purpose by requiring an annual
