A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE HAWAII CORRECTIONAL SYSTEM OVERSIGHT COMMISSION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 353L-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows: 3 "(a) The governor shall appoint an oversight coordinator 4 from a list of three nominees submitted by the commission. The 5 oversight coordinator shall be a person qualified by training 6 and experience to administer the Hawaii correctional system 7 oversight commission and shall be well-versed in criminal justice reform and maintain a firm commitment to the 8 9 correctional system's transition to a rehabilitative and 10 therapeutic model. The oversight coordinator shall serve a 11 [two-year] three-year term[-]; provided that at the end of the 12 coordinator's term, the Hawaii correctional system oversight 13 commission may review the coordinator's performance and make a 14 recommendation to the governor whether the coordinator should be 15 retained for an additional term." 16 SECTION 2. Section 353L-7, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 17 amended by amending subsection (c) to read as follows:

| 12 | SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2025. |
