A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO NURSING.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. The legislature finds that Hawaii faces a
growing nursing workforce shortage, with the current demand for
nurses exceeding supply by approximately one thousand positions.
Experts have recommended expanding the capacity of university
nursing programs to help reduce nursing workforce shortages.

6 The legislature further finds that the county of Maui is the largest county in the State without a college or university 7 bachelor of science in nursing degree program. The university 8 of Hawaii Maui college's nursing program offers two degrees: a 9 certificate of achievement and an associate in science in 10 11 nursing. Students who earn an associate in science in nursing 12 must then transfer to the bachelor of science in nursing pathway 13 at the university of Hawaii at Manoa to further their education.

14 The legislature believes that offering a bachelor of 15 science in nursing program at the university of Hawaii Maui 16 college can help to increase the supply of nurse graduates,

2	students to remain on Maui during their entire course of study.
3	The legislature declares that the establishment of a
4	bachelor of science in nursing program in the county of Maui is
5	a matter of statewide concern pursuant to article X, section 6,
6	of the Hawaii State Constitution.
7	The purpose of this Act is to appropriate moneys for the
8	establishment of a bachelor of science in nursing degree program
9	at the university of Hawaii Maui college.
10	SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
11	revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$250,000 or so much
12	thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2025-2026 and the
13	sum of \$350,000 or so much thereof as may be necessary for
14	fiscal year 2026-2027 to:
15	(1) Establish a bachelor of science in nursing degree
16	program at the university of Hawaii Maui college;
17	(2) Fund additional personnel associated with the
18	establishment of the program; and
19	(3) Purchase related supplies and equipment.
20	The sums appropriated shall be expended by the university
21	of Hawaii for the purposes of this Act.
